BECOMING A kinship caregiver

Studies have shown that children who cannot remain safely in their original home have better outcomes when placed with relative or fictive kin caregivers. This arrangement allows children to maintain a strong attachment to their family, culture, and community.

Support is available to kinship caregivers through the Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services.

- Average Daily Per Diem of \$24.10 (\$723 a month per child)
- One Time Placement Support Benefit of \$350 per child, up to 6 children
- Child Care
- Respite Care
- Medical Coverage
- Tuition Adoption Assistance
- Foster/Adoptive Mentors

TEMPORARY CUSTODIAN BENEFITS

- One Time Placement Support Benefit of \$350 per child, up to 6 children
- K-TAP (Must be a blood relative, \$372 a month for one child, does not go up exponentially)
- Child Care Assistance
- Medical Coverage
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (Subject to Income Eligibility Requirements)
